Lancaster County & Court of Common Pleas Seeking Applications for Youth Intervention Center Board of Managers

Lancaster, PA – As a Class 2A County, Lancaster County Youth Intervention Center's Board is required to consist of the three County Commissioners, the County Controller, and six private citizens; three of whom are to be appointed by the President Judge of the Court of Common Pleas and three of whom shall be appointed by the Chairperson of the Board of County Commissioners.

The Youth Intervention Center provides detention, shelter care and alternative treatment programs and services for adolescents who have been court adjudicated as delinquent or dependent. Members of the public with an interest or background in juvenile justice and/or child welfare issues; who have a commitment to the Center's core values of teamwork, safety, integrity, respect, and compassion; and who are willing to actively participate in quarterly Board meetings are encouraged to apply via one, but not both, of the following links:

All applications must be submitted with a resume and a statement of interest to support consideration of your appointment no later than Monday, March 3, 2025, at 4:00pm. Please note that all applicants shall be subject to and by submitting an application agree to undergo a complete personal and criminal background investigation. Phone calls and email inquiries will not be entertained by the County or the Court. It is anticipated that all selections will be made by March 31, 2025. Newly selected board members will participate in the next scheduled meeting on Friday, May 2, 2025, at 10:00am.

Please note that County employees are prohibited by statute from being appointed to this Board. Court employees are prohibited from being appointed to this Board by the Code of Conduct for Employees of the Unified Judicial System.
